He began his professional life in 1985 with joining The British Library at Ahmedabad after completion of Master's in Library and Information Science from University of Delhi. He had an opportunity to work with R & D of LML Ltd, Kanpur, Indian Express, Delhi, Zee Telefilms, Noida and for a brief period at London, UK. At LML Ltd, he started publishing an indexed and Abstract journal called 'LML Technical Abstracts'. At Zee Telefilms, his contribution was applauded when the daily transmission log of Zee TV was successfully synchronized with the Library database. This system was used by Zee Telefilms for its entire network globally. He worked as Secretary of Indian Library Association for two years. He contributed as Managing Editor of ILA Bulletin. He was associated with IGNOU for nearly twenty years as an academic counsellor. The Delhi Library Association conferred 'Distinguished Faculty Award' to him in 2015.



Mr. Santhanam Iyengar superannuate from his dedicated service as Administrative Officer on 30th September, 2019 after attaining the age of 60 years. Get-together was held by college Staff Associations which was attended by his family members & well-wishers.

He has the work experience of almost four decades. He started his career at the age of 19. He worked in Indian Institute of Foreign Trade (Ministry of Commerce) from November 81 to July 83.
