It has always been conceived as an all-India institute of interdisciplinary research and training in social sciences. The principal objective of the Institute is conducting research, pure and applied, in social sciences and enlarging the canvas to include doctoral programme, training and policy dissemination.

The main objectives of the Institute summarily stated are to:

- undertake pure and applied research in social sciences encompassing all aspects of a developing society in an inter-disciplinary framework;
- assist central, state and local governments by providing advice based on policy-related studies;
- undertake regular training of doctoral students and teachers in universities and colleges, and for the officials and political functionaries, particularly at local levels;
- maintain a documentation and data centre in social sciences;
- take all measures within the competence of the Institute for the promotion of pure and applied research in social and economic development and change;
- assist the multilateral organisations such as the World Bank, Asian Development Bank, UNFPA , UNICEF, WHO and ILO in undertaking research and training programmes and
- collaborate with universities, research institutions and the non-governmental organisations (NGO) in the region in improving the quality of research and training

Education and Human Development are the core focus areas of the Centre for Human Resource Development (CHRD). The Centre works through research, education, extension training and consultation, to contribute to knowledge creation, public policy, reform and revitalization of public institutions and professionals.

The Centre for Education has been integral to the Institute's conception of social development and transformation from its inception. Over the years, the Centre has contributed to education and related aspects of human development including health and nutrition within the State of Karnataka and nationally. The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, the Karnataka State Department of Education, and several national agencies such as the Planning Commission, the National Council for Education Research and Training, the National University of Education Planning and Administration, the Indian Council for Social Science Research, the University Grants Commission, BARC, Mumbai, as well as International agencies such as the UNESCO, the UNICEF and the World Bank support research and training programmes of the Centre.

GOALS AND MISSION

- To engage in research in the emerging areas of concerns relating to education and human development, including school education, higher education, non-formal and vocational education, children, youth and adults;
- To undertake studies and action-research relating to policy as well as evaluation of the on-going programmes in education and health, nutrition and well being;
- To develop and offer a rigorous multi-disciplinary and methodological training in key areas of the Centre's interest through the PhD and other capacity-building programmes;
- To develop and offer programmes for capacity building in education and human development sectors for researchers, faculty and professionals;
- To collaborate nationally and internationally for teaching, research and action research;
- To contribute to a vibrant discourse in the State and at the national level through outreach programmes, by engaging with academics and researchers, teachers, NGOs and policy makers; and to disseminate research findings in academic journals and public forums.

RESEARCH PERSPECTIVE

The Right to Education 2009 draws attention to the centrality of human development in the current phase of Indian social policy. The Centre focuses on issues of education and health with a strong social justice and equity concern, at the state and national levels. Both empirical and conceptual work as well as innovations in methodology informs the Centre's orientation to research. Current key thrust areas include:

- Human Development: education and health and education and work transitions; Role of human development (education and health) in growth and development, promoting income redistribution and social mobility.
- Quality and Education in new contexts such as liberalization, privatization, PPPs and forms of state involvement in education.
- Comparative education, teacher education, childhood, indigenous knowledge
- Policy and Macro-level problems and issues (access to health and basic education, nutrition; planning and management; development and disparities; social and gender concerns);
- Social justice and equity, with focus on education of children from SCs, STs, religious and linguistic minorities, education of the girl child and inclusive education, community involvement in education.

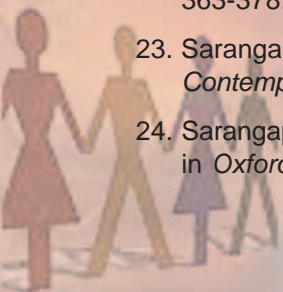
